All students have to bring their own instruments with them; only Piano and Drums are available at school. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Instrument and singing courses consist of 5 lessons of private tuition. • The Instrument and singing courses with coaching consist of 5 lessons of private tuition accompanied on the piano. 				
CANTO AND DICTION FOR SINGERS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Canto and Diction for Singers course consists of 5 lessons of private tuition in singing. • The Canto and Diction for Singers course with coaching consists of 5 lessons of private tuition in singing plus 2 lessons accompanied on the piano. • The courses also concentrate on improving Italian diction. 				
THE LANGUAGE OF THE LIBRETTI	The Language of the Libretti course has a duration of two weeks and consists of four lessons in an intensive language course plus two private tutorials on the professional field of the language of the Opera, each day. An intermediate knowledge of Italian is recommended for those attending this course.

Notes	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For Instrument and Canto courses, there are 3 levels of ability: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Beginner = up to two years' study; - Intermediate = from two to five years' study; - Expert = over five years' study. • Each lesson has a duration of 60 minutes, except "The Language of the Libretti" course = 45 minutes per lesson. • All courses can be extended. • Course centers: Florence - Rome: The Instrument and Canto courses are organized in collaboration with the Music Schools "Il Trillo" in Florence and "Cantare l'Opera" in Rome.
